International Student Awards

Award	Value	Description
Emerging Market Entrance Awards	\$1,000 - \$4,000 Equal to the value of the Brock Scholars Awards for which the student is eligible in the first year of study.	Students will automatically receive the award if they are citizens of: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Colombia, Costa Rica, Curacao, Ecuador, Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Turkey, Ukraine or Vietnam.
International Curriculum Awards	\$1,000	Students are automatically considered if they have achieved an A- admissions average* and one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IB diploma successful completion • AP: incoming first year undergraduate students with three AP courses with an exam score of 3 or more • A-level final year average of C or higher
International Student Ambassador Award	\$20,000** **Selected students will receive an award in the amount of the difference between international and domestic rates.	Awarded annually to a maximum of 15 students who do not hold citizenship, permanent residency or refugee status in Canada. Must be registered in full-time undergraduate or graduate studies for the 2020/21 academic year. Student can apply at time of admission or any year starting in Year 1 of Undergraduate or Graduate studies. Visit brocku.ca/ambassadors to apply.
Caribbean International Scholarship	\$4,000	Awarded annually to two students from a Caribbean nation who demonstrate financial need, and academic promise. Award considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded on academic promise and financial need • Awarded to entering 1st year students • Undergraduate only • Non-renewable • Application accessed via OneApp

Brock Scholars Awards

Students are automatically considered if they meet the following qualifications:

- Achieved an A- admissions average or higher*
- Have no previous post-secondary experience

Amount	Academic average
\$16,000 (\$4,000 each year)	93%* and above
\$10,000 (\$2,500 each year)	90% to 92.9%*
\$6,000 (\$1,500 each year)	85% to 89.9%*
\$4,000 (\$1,000 each year)	80% to 84.9%*

*Marks are based on Ontario academic equivalencies as determined by Brock University.

To qualify, you must be entering your 1st undergraduate program in the Fall or Winter term with no previous post-secondary experience. International applicants to Brock are automatically considered for the Brock Scholars Awards.
