Scholarship decisions are made on the basis of the candidate's interim average, based on the best five eligible courses (listed below). Scholarship offers are not adjusted on final grades.</i></p>

<p><b>International Baccalaureate Scholarship Enhancement</b></p> <p>Eligibility: All applicants</p>	<p><b>\$150-\$250</b></p>	<p>Held with any University of Manitoba Entrance Scholarship (including BMO Leader of Tomorrow, Entrance Scholarship, International Student Entrance Scholarship, Chown Centennial Scholarship, or International Baccalaureate Entrance Scholarship)</p> <p>For each result, awards are provided as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>\$150 award: IB result of five on higher level papers</li> <li>\$200 award: IB result of seven on standard level papers or six on higher level papers</li> <li>\$250 award: IB result of seven on higher level papers</li> </ul>	<p>Submission of undergraduate application for admission</p>	<p>March 1, 2021</p>
