SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > SPM/O Levels, A Grade average in all academic subjects (forecast results accepted)
- > Senior High School 2 (Chinese Independent School), overall average of 80%
- > other qualifications may be considered, results need to be minimum 75% average.

A\$5,000

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > SPM/O Levels, B Grade average in all academic subjects (forecast results accepted)
- > Senior High School 2 (Chinese Independent School), overall average of 70%
- > other qualifications may be considered, results need to be minimum 65% average.

Pre-Master's Program (2 semesters):

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > Upon meeting entry requirements

Degree Transfer Program: A\$8,000

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > A Levels / STPM min of 2 D grades (forecast results accepted), OR
- > UEC 27 points or fewer from best 5 academic subjects
- > Canadian Year 12 qualification with minimum of 65%
- > IB Diploma 25 points or above
- > other qualifications may be considered, results need to be minimum 65% average.

Pre-Master's Program (1 semester):

- > Upon meeting entry requirements

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > Graduate of the University of Adelaide College
- > Average grade of a minimum of 85% (Foundation Studies) or GPA 6.0 (DT or PMP)

The University of Adelaide College International Scholarship:

10%

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- > Graduate of the University of Adelaide College
- > Accept your offer as an international full-fee paying student, and study full time.



It is not necessary for College graduates to apply for the University's scholarships as they are awarded automatically. Scholarships will be confirmed at the point of acceptance.

The University of Adelaide College Terms and Conditions

- Scholarship is only available to full-fee paying international students
 - The tuition fee scholarship applies only to the Foundation Studies or Degree Transfer Program total tuition fees.
 - Applicants who are offered a University of Adelaide College scholarship must pay their semester 1 tuition fees in full and all additional fees (as stated in the scholarship offer) within 14 days of the offer issue date.
- If the payment is not received within the time period stated, the scholarship offer will be withdrawn.
- Student must meet English entry requirement to qualify for the scholarship.
 - The full scholarship amount will be automatically deducted from the final semester tuition fee.
 - Other qualifications will be considered and assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Value of the scholarships

The University of Adelaide High Achiever Progression Scholarship 2021–2025 offers a 25% tuition fee reduction for the minimum standard full-time duration of the scholar's chosen undergraduate degree.

The University of Adelaide College International Scholarship 2021–2025 offers a 10% tuition fee reduction for the minimum standard full-time duration of the scholar's chosen undergraduate degree.

Scholarships in this program have the following conditions:

- Available for graduates of the University of Adelaide College commencing at the University of Adelaide in the period between 2021–2025;
- Open to citizens of any country (except Australia and New Zealand);
- Provides a waiver of 25% (The University of Adelaide High Achiever Scholarship) or 10% (The University of Adelaide College International Scholarship) of the annual tuition fee for each year of the program for the full duration of the degree.

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a graduate of the University of Adelaide College;
- Minimum grade average of 85% or GPA 6.0;
- Have a University of Adelaide offer of admission (full offer or conditional offer) as a full-fee-paying international student;
- Enrol in a full time study load for each study period of the degree;
- Complete the acceptance process as outlined in your offer of admission.

For the High Achiever Scholarship the eligibility for this scholarship is determined by:

The top 100 commencing international students with an average grade of a minimum of 85% or higher in the last program studied at the University of Adelaide College prior to progressing to the University of Adelaide.

Note: Scholarship applicants who are eligible for more than one scholarship offered by the University of Adelaide will only be entitled to receive one scholarship (the highest value scholarship award for which they are eligible).

Exclusions

The following applicants are not eligible to receive these scholarships:

Current University of Adelaide students who are transferring from one degree to another prior to successful completion of their program of study (internal transfers)

Students who are recipients of a scholarship covering tuition fees awarded by a recognised scholarship awarding body such as a government ministry or department

Applicants for Masters by Research or PhD programs

Applicants for certain programs; see the website address below for a list of excluded degrees.
