Applicants only need to submit one application form to be considered for both scholarships, and the closing date to be considered for the Dean's International Excellence Awards is 30 November 2021.

If you're applying for postgraduate research degree programme, you'll receive a scholarship award equivalent to a 15% reduction of your tuition fees for each year of study. Postgraduate research degree applicants can apply year round for the scholarships.
