### Eligibility criteria

To be considered for a GREAT scholarship, you must:

- Be a national of one of the following countries: Bangladesh, Malaysia or, Sri Lanka
- Be assessed as international for tuition fee purposes
- Be self-funded
- Hold an offer from Teesside University (Conditional or Unconditional) by 30 April 2022 for a postgraduate taught one-year master's programme, commencing September 2022

To be considered for a GREAT Justice and Law Scholarship, you must be a national of Nigeria and intend to study one of the following courses:
