As an INTO UEA student you could be eligible for a scholarship worth up to £5,000 off your UEA tuition fees or, if you're a prospective Newton student, up to 50% off your tuition fees.

International Foundation Progressions Scholarship

Awarded upon successful completion of your International Foundation Programme:

- Achieve your UEA offer and receive £1,000 off your first-year tuition fee.
- Achieve 70%+ and receive £3,000 off your first-year tuition fee (standard international fee).
- Achieve 70%+ and receive £5,000 off your first-year tuition fee (for degrees with an international lab fee).*

International Year One in International Development and Media

As a successful recipient you will receive:

- £2,000 off your International Year One tuition fee at INTO UEA.
- £2,000 off your tuition fees in years 2 and 3 of study.

International Graduate Diploma

UEA offers automatic scholarships of £3,000 – 4,000 for INTO UEA graduate diploma students from a selection of countries progressing to UEA. Students can also apply for a range of merit-based scholarships such as International Excellence Scholarship or UEA China High Achiever Award.

International and EU Scholarship Scheme

From 2023, all International Year One students are eligible to apply for the International & EU Scholarship Scheme.

Newton Science Progression Scholarship

Newton students could be eligible for up to £5,000 towards each year of study at UEA if they:

- Hold an unconditional offer for UEA's Faculty of Science.
- Choose UEA as one of their UCAS choices.
- Have successfully completed the Newton A Level Programme at the level required for admission.

Newton A Levels

High achieving (7-9/A & A*) Newton students are eligible for unlimited scholarships worth up to 50% of tuition fees.
