ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate (Bachelors)

- STPM Grades A to C in three subjects
- UEC a minimum score of B or above in 5 relevant subjects (not including English, Malay and Chinese)
- Canadian Pre-University (CPU) 60% in six advanced level Grade 12 U, U/C or M subjects (including grade 12 U English)
- Australian Pre-University, University of Queensland (IES) pass in Foundation year with Credit of 65-74%
- South Australian Matriculation (SAM) 65%-75% in minimum of two subjects PLUS SPM Maths Grade C minimum
- Applicants holding Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas can be considered for a 2nd year or 3rd year advanced entry to our undergraduate courses
- IELTS 6.0 overall with a minimum of 5.5 in each component, or SPM 1119 English Grade A-C; SPM English CEFR B2

Postgraduate (Taught)

- Bachelor's degree with a 2.2 lower second degree, or minimum CGPA 2.4 out of 4.0
- IELTS 6.0 overall with a minimum of 5.5 in each component

Postgraduate (Research)

- For MRes, a Bachelor's degree with a min CGPA of 3.0 or above
- For Doctorate and PhD, a master's degree in a related subject field or hold relevant work experience
- In addition, some programmes may require work experience and/or a strong portfolio of work
- Applicant s are expected to submit a research proposal
- IELTS 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in writing, 5.5 in other components
