- ESL only students and visiting students will receive \$4,300/year amount provided they are enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours
- · Up to 8 semesters
- . Graduate and current students are **not** eligible
- . Students receiving special tuition rates as part of a partnership agreement are **not** eligible
- Only those students attending the **Kent campus** are eligible to receive the Global Scholarship
- F1 visa holders only
- Must be admitted by July 1st for Fall semester, November 1st for Spring semester and March 1st for Summer semester
- Automatically renew each year, awarded students simply need to maintain continuous in-person full-time enrollment at Kent campus and good academic standing



Graduate Assistantship

Up to 20 hours of work per week for the department **Full tuition waiver** and/or a **monthly stipend**

Teaching or Research Fellowship

Up to 20 hours of work per week focus exclusively on teaching or research **Full tuition waiver** and/or a **monthly stipend**

- A student must be enrolled full-time (i.e., at least eight credit hours per semester) in a specific degree program.
- University-funded assistantships may be awarded, competitively, to those students who have applied for an appointment and who are academically eligible.
- We highly recommend **contacting the graduate coordinator for the department** that you are applying to or have been admitted to in order to **inquire about assistantship opportunities available** in the academic department. Most assistantships are awarded to doctoral students and some programs fund 100% of their graduate students while others do not. It is important to contact the program directly to see how they structure their assistantships.
- The application for a graduate **appointment is included as part of your application** packet for admission to Kent State.
