TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR MCKL SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

(Partial listing only)

General Terms & Conditions

(Not applicable to External Scholarships)

1. With the exception of MCKL's Principal's Scholarship and Excellence Award Scholarship, all applicants are required to pay the requisite application fee and admission deposit to be considered for the award.
2. With the exception of MCKL Special Bursary, applicants must be below the age of 25 years and have enrolled in a full time MCKL programme.
3. For academic-based awards, actual results must be obtained no more than 2 years before commencement of the semester.
4. Applicants may apply for more than one MCKL scholarship/ bursary/ financial aid/ discount (collectively, "award") at any one time but will be permitted to benefit from only one award, which shall generally be the award with the highest quantum.
5. The award, unless specifically indicated, is open to Malaysian citizens only.
6. In the event a recipient is offered and accepts any scholarship, bursary, financial aid or other sponsorship for their MCKL studies from any other entity or person, (s)he shall inform the Office of the Registrar in writing within two (2) weeks of such acceptance. The Institution reserves the right to withdraw or adjust the offered quantum of the award to the recipient. Recipients who fail to inform the Office of the Registrar may face disciplinary action and/or be required to reimburse the full value of the disbursed award to MCKL.
7. The offered award is not applicable to and does not cover:
 - Subjects/Credit hours in which no examinations/ assessments were attempted;
 - Withdrawn/Dropped subjects; and
 - Repeat subjects/papers;
8. All the awarded recipients are required to pass Service Learning and Character Formation subjects in order to maintain the award. However:
 - ADTP students are not required to take Character Formation;
9. The award may not be transferred to other programmes or deferred to other intakes except with the prior written consent of MCKL. Such consent may be withheld at MCKL's absolute discretion.
10. In the event that the recipient is suspended or expelled by MCKL at any time before completion of the programme, the award shall terminate and be automatically revoked. MCKL reserves the right to require the recipient to reimburse the full value of the disbursed award in such events.
11. MCKL reserves the right to involve award recipients in various activities of the institution, including interviews, MCKL events, education events, social media, photography/ videos, and other promotional activities of MCKL.
12. Awards are given at the sole discretion of MCKL. Applicants are not guaranteed approval of the award notwithstanding fulfilling the conditions set. MCKL reserves the right to amend any criteria and/or terms and conditions of the award as and when it deems necessary. The decision of MCKL on all matters pertaining to the awards are absolute and final.
13. Awards are not transferable or cannot be encashed and does not include external examination fees (if applicable) or textbooks.

14. The award is based upon the number of subjects attempted in each semester's final exams and is limited to the following number of subjects/modules/credit hours (whichever is applicable based on the respective award):

Australian Matriculation	Maximum of 5 subjects
ACCA FIA	Maximum of 7 modules
American Degree Transfer Program	Maximum of 2 years**
Diploma Programmes (full-time)	Maximum of 2.5 years or 90 cumulative credit hours, whichever comes first
ACCA (full-time) Level 1 or Level 2 entry only	Maximum of 3 years or 13 papers, whichever comes first. Only applicable for Financial Aid, Student Leader & Achievement Award and Merit Scholarship

A) Merit Scholarship

1. Successful applicants will be notified after submission of results.
2. The following table is the equivalency of grades across SPM and IGCSE examinations:

SPM (Grade A+)	Cambridge IGCSE Grade A* / Edexcel IGCSE Grade 8 & 9
SPM (Grade A)	Cambridge IGCSE Grade A / Edexcel IGCSE Grade 7

3. For SPM results, English 1119 will not be considered in the overall SPM results.
4. For Cambridge IGCSE results, applicants may combine results from different examination boards and multiple examination sittings provided there are no overlapping subjects and within a 12-month period.
3. Recipients are required to pay the first semester fees in full before the commencement of the semester. Scholarship disbursement will commence from the second semester onwards.

B) MCKL Special Scholarships & Financial Aid

i) MCKL Excellence Award Scholarship

1. The Scholarship is open to eligible applicants enrolled under any MCKL full time programmes with the exception of the ACCA programme.
2. Applicants may apply for the Scholarship with forecast or trial results but will be required to provide actual results to MCKL within 7 days of release thereof as proof of meeting the criteria and shall provide the following:
 - evidence of academic excellence; and
 - evidence of excellence in personal attributes in their final two (2) years of schooling, such as leadership, notable achievements, active extra-curricular involvement, or other exemplary behaviour, attitude or self-motivation; and
 - proof of household income (Tax Return form, salary slips)
3. The Scholarship recipients are required to maintain an academic progress of a minimum of GPA 3.20 (ADTP, A Level, AUSMAT, Diploma programmes) or an average of 70% (ACCA FIA internal assessments) for each semester throughout the programme.

ii) Student Leader & Achievement Award

1. The Student Leader and Achievement Award ("Award") is open to students who hold leadership positions AND/OR evidence outstanding achievements or other exemplary behaviour or accomplishments within their school or other communities.
2. Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview and will be notified via e-mail. Shortlisted applicants who fail to respond to the e-mail by the stipulated deadline will be removed from consideration for the Award.

iii) Financial Aid

1. Financial Aid ("Aid") is available to students from families whose gross immediate household income is less than RM4,000.00 per month or RM48,000 per year.
2. The Aid will be disbursed on a semester-by-semester basis. Unless otherwise specified, the Aid will not be backdated to cover for semesters which have been completed.

■ C) Methodist Affiliated Scholarships

1. The Scholarship is open to eligible applicants enrolled under any MCKL programme with the exception of the ACCA programme.
2. Scholarship recipients are required to maintain an academic progress of a minimum GPA of 2.20 (ADTP, A Level, AUSMAT, Diploma programmes) or an average of 55% (ACCA FIA internal assessments) for each semester throughout the programme. Recipients of the Member of the Local Methodist Church Scholarship are exempted from this requirement.

Specific terms and conditions for various categories

1. The Scholarships for Pastor's Children and Methodist Church Members are applicable only to Malaysians, whose church is registered under Council of Churches in Malaysia (CCM) or National Evangelical Christian Fellowship (NECF).
2. National SPM Bible Knowledge Quiz Scholarship recipients are required to adhere to the terms and conditions stated on the certificate of award.

■ D) MCKL Discount/Bursaries

i) MCKL Alumni Discount

1. The Alumni Discount Scheme ("Scheme") is open to all alumni enrolling in any full time MCKL programme within two years of completion of the A Levels/ AUSMAT/ CAT/ ACCA FIA programme at MCKL.
2. Alumni who are scholarship holders are eligible for the Scheme save and except for alumni receiving 75% and above scholarships from MCKL or other parties.
3. Alumni who qualify for the Scheme will receive discounts reflected in the first and second semester invoices of the programme, at RM 500.00 each.

iii) Bursary for Selected High Schools / Home Schools Centres

1. The bursary is not applicable to the ACCA programme.

2. Applicants for the Sibling Bursary must have a sibling who has completed or is currently completing a fulltime programme in MCKL. Sibling Bursary can only be awarded once per applicant throughout the studies at MCKL.

iv) MCKL Special Bursary

1. The MCKL Special Bursary ("Bursary") applies to the following programmes: Diploma in Computer Science, Diploma in Digital Business, Diploma in Information Technology, Diploma in Digital Marketing and Diploma in Financial Technology.
2. Students are required to maintain an academic progress of a minimum of GPA 2.20 for each semester throughout the programme (for 50% MCKL Special Bursary only).

■ E) MCKL-Industry Scholarship

1. The MCKL Industry Scholarship (hereinafter referred as MCKLIS) is open for Diploma in Computer Science, Diploma in Information Technology, Diploma in Digital Business, Diploma in Digital Marketing and Diploma in Financial Technology applicants.
2. This MCKLIS may be awarded to students from families whose gross immediate household income is less than RM4,000.00 per month or RM48,000.00 per year.
3. Recipients are required to maintain an academic progress of a minimum GPA of 2.50 for each semester throughout the programme.
