## International Scholarships 2024/2025

University of Galway is committed to attracting high-calibre students from around the world. To this end, we offer a range of merit-based scholarships to students from a number of outside of the EU countries, in line with our strategic international priorities. For international students commencing study at University of Galway they are a number of different scholarships on offer.

### Global Achievement Scholarship (Undergraduate)

University of Galway is delighted to offer a Global Achievement Scholarship to eligible applicants, providing a €2,000 reduction in tuition fees for their first year of undergraduate study. There is no need to apply separately for this scholarship, as all eligible candidates will be automatically considered based on their academic results and personal statement.

To qualify for this scholarship, successful candidates must be:

- assessed as international for fee purposes
- self-funded (ie not receive funding from any other external sources such as government or employer sponsorship)

and have:

- met the conditions outlined in your full-time undergraduate course offer letter
- secured a place for full-time study at the University of Galway on an eligible programme starting in September 2024.
- accepted your offer by Wednesday, 1 May 2024.

Please note that eligible programmes for this scholarship are limited to bachelor's degrees offered by the [College of Arts, Social Sciences and Celtic Studies](#), and the [J.E. Cairnes School of Business and Economics](#).

If you are selected to receive this scholarship, a letter confirming your award will be sent to you.

- For international applicants, one merit scholarship is available per programme, awarded up to 50% of the tuition fees, for the majority of courses.
- To be eligible for consideration, candidates must have achieved a H1 (or international equivalent) in their primary degree. There is no application form to be completed as part of this process.
- Eligible students who have accepted their offer and paid their deposit before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024 will be automatically considered by the review team.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a highly competitive basis.
- All successful applicants will be notified directly via email. Those successful will be asked to complete a short form to confirm receipt of the scholarship.

To be considered for one of our Merit Scholarships no additional application is required. Once you have completed the steps below you are automatically considered for the merit scholarship.

1. You must have received an offer to study on any of the Undergraduate Full Degree Programmes at the College of Arts, Social Sciences and Celtic Studies.
2. You must Have accepted your offer by **1<sup>st</sup> May 2024**.
3. Paid your deposit by **1<sup>st</sup> May 2024**.

### Postgraduate steps to follow:

1. Have received an offer to study on any of our Postgraduate Taught Programmes at the College of Arts, Social Sciences and Celtic Studies.
2. Have accepted your offer by **1<sup>st</sup> April 2024**.
3. Paid your deposit by **1<sup>st</sup> April 2024**.
