- You can only be in receipt of one University of the West of England scholarship. If you meet the eligibility criteria for more than one of the scholarships, you will be awarded the scholarship which is the most beneficial to you (unless otherwise stated).
- Successful candidates will be notified in writing. Full terms and conditions for the scholarship will be sent with the scholarship award letter.
- All scholarships will be given as a tuition fee remission.
- These are one-off awards, which are non-renewable after the first year of study unless otherwise specified.
- All scholarships, unless otherwise specified, are non-deferrable. If you are offered a scholarship and then choose to defer your place, the offer of the scholarship will be withdrawn and you will have to reapply or will be reconsidered for the scholarship again the following year.
- We reserve the right to defer the scholarship to the next intake should the programme not run.

EXCEPTIONS PLEASE NOTE:

- Scholarships are not available in respect of the English language pre-sessional programmes.
- The MBA, BTC, LPC, GDL, MSc Robotics and postgraduate research degrees courses are not eligible for the Chancellor's and Millennium 50% tuition fees postgraduate scholarships.
