Eligibility

- Your studies at Murdoch College must commence in 2024.
- You are an academic pathways student at Murdoch College.
- Standalone enrolments in an English for Academic Purposes (EAP) or General English program is not eligible for the scholarship
- You must not be a recipient of other College scholarships or grants, or a government-sponsored student for the duration of a College scholarship.

You do not need to apply for a scholarship as it is automatically awarded to students who meet all eligibility criteria at the time of admission.

Welcome Back International Scholarship

Students who successfully complete their Foundation Studies, Murdoch University Preparation Course, Diplomas or Postgraduate Qualifying Program with Murdoch College will be eligible for a 20% Welcome Back International Scholarship for the duration of their university course if they commence their studies at Murdoch University in 2024 (excluding the Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Veterinary Biology, Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) and Master of Clinical Psychology as these are ineligible courses).
