How do you apply?

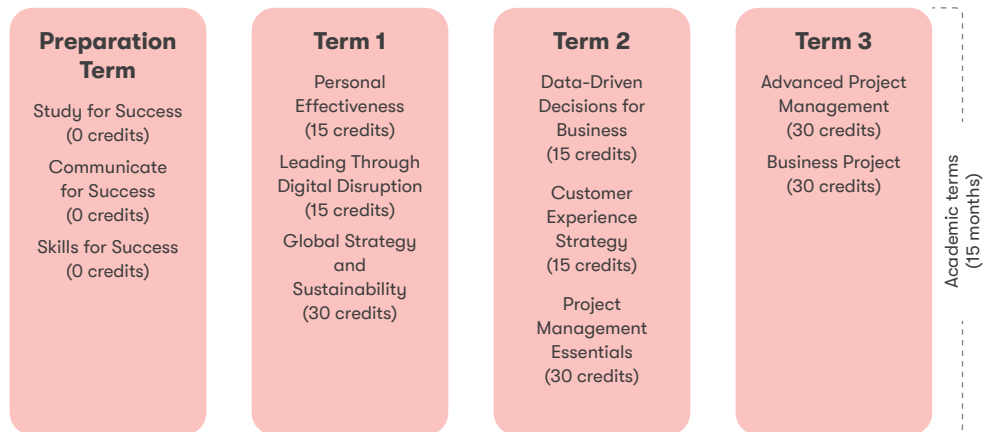
We recommend you apply for your chosen intake as early as possible. For application instructions, please contact our Admissions team for further information.
