Specific Terms & Conditions

- The scholarship holder is required to achieve a minimum CGPA of 3.25 every semester to maintain the scholarship. Failure to do so will result in the scholarship being withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.
- For Foundation or Diploma holders pursuing HCUC Bachelor's Degree, the scholarship quantum awarded is strictly based on the final CGPA obtained from Foundation or Diploma qualification. No appeal is allowed.
- The scholarship holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

- Only applicable for students who have graduated with a Bachelor's Degree within twelve (12) months from the application date of the Master's Degree.
- Only applicable for Master's Degree by Research (Full Time) students.
- Strictly limited to two (2) years of the Master's Degree.
- The scholarship holder is required to maintain satisfactory progress in every progress monitoring cycle throughout their duration of study to enjoy the scholarship, failing to do so, the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- The scholarship holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- The scholarship will be disbursed over two semesters (second and last semester) during the programme and fully disbursed on and before the Award Duration subject always to the sole and absolute discretion of the HCUC whenever it deems fit and proper.

- Complete the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application Form, with the required supporting documents.
- Attach the Certified True Copy document(s) for the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application:
 - Certificate of Achievement for sports participated and won at the state, national or international level. The Certificate of Achievement which was won within 2 years preceding the application date will only be considered.
 - Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- The scholarship holder is required to achieve a minimum CGPA of 3.00 every semester to maintain the scholarship. Failure to do so will result in the scholarship being withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.
- The scholarship holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

- National athletes who represent Malaysia in Sanctioned International Games or Championships (i.e. ASEAN University Games, Southeast Asian Games).
 - Contribution Hour will be waived for scholarship holders who participate and win at least a bronze medal during the course of study.
 - 30 hours of the Contribution Hour will be waived for scholarship holders who participate but do not win any medal during the course of study.
- State athletes who represent National Sanctioned Games or Championships (i.e. MSSM, SUKMA, SUKIPT, SIPMA).
 - 45 hours of the Contribution Hour will be waived for scholarship holders who participate and win at least a bronze medal during the course of study.
 - 15 hours of the Contribution Hour will be waived for scholarship holders who participate but do not win any medal during the course of study.
- The scholarship holder is trusted to acknowledge and uphold the reputation of HCUC at all times in the games participated.

Secondary School Teacher & Han Chiang Staff Recognition Scholarship

 - Applicant's birth certificate.
 - Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
 - Secondary school teacher/staff identification documents/member identification documents.
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- The scholarship holder is required to achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.75 every semester to maintain the scholarship. Failure to do so will result in the scholarship being withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.

HCUC Special Bursary

Applicable to HCUC Foundation / HCUC Diploma / HCUC Bachelor's Degree

- This bursary is awarded solely to needy students from B40 or M40 families, single parent or OKU.
- For the April and August intake (applicable for Diploma and Degree programmes only), applicants must first submit their applications for the MSEF SIYUAN Scholarship. Consideration of Special Bursary will only follow in the event the MSEF SIYUAN Scholarship application is rejected.
- Up to 50% tuition fee waiver (subject to decision of scholarship board).

Specific Terms & Conditions

- The bursary holder is required to achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.50 every semester to maintain the bursary. Failure to do so will result in the bursary being withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.
- The bursary holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

 - The applicant needs to submit the original application letter at the Student Services.
 - SPM/UEC/Foundation/Diploma/STPM certificate, result slip(s) or transcript.
 - Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
 - For B40, M40 and Single Parent,
 - Both parents' Identity Card (MyKad) front & back.
 - Parent Identity Card (MyKad) front & back. (Applicable for Single Parent)
 - Parents' latest 3 months' payslips.
 - Relevant supporting documents (i.e. financial aid received from government or charitable organisations).
 - For OKU,
 - OKU Card from Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat.
 - Parents' latest 3 months' payslips.
 - Relevant supporting documents (i.e. financial aid received from government or charitable organisations).
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Special Entrance for High School & UEC Students Bursary

Han Chiang High School Principal's Recommendation Bursary Award

Applicable to HCUC Foundation / HCUC Diploma / HCUC Bachelor's Degree

- This bursary is awarded to Han Chiang High School students with the Principal's Recommendation.
- Up to 100% tuition fee waiver (subject to decision of scholarship board).

High School Principal's Recommendation Bursary Award

Applicable to HCUC Foundation / HCUC Diploma / HCUC Bachelor's Degree

- This bursary is awarded to High School students from Private or Government (SMK/SMJK) schools with the Principal's Recommendation.
- Up to 50% tuition fee waiver (subject to decision of scholarship board).

Application Procedure

- Complete the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application Form, with the required supporting documents.
- Attach the Certified True Copy document(s) for the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application:
 - Recommendation letter signed by High School Principal.
 - Certified True Copy is non-applicable for the letter.
 - The applicant needs to submit the original recommendation letter at the Student Services.
 - Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- The bursary holder is required to achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.75 every semester to maintain the bursary. Failure to do so will result in the bursary being withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.
- The bursary holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

- Complete the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application Form, with the required supporting documents.
- Attach the Certified True Copy document(s) for the Online Scholarship/Bursary Application:
 - i. Birth certificates of Alumni and sibling (Applicable for Alumni's Sibling Bursary) OR
 - ii. HCUC Foundation/HCUC Diploma certificate and transcript (Applicable for HCUC Alumni Bursary).
 - iii. Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- Siblings Bursary applies to the alumni's siblings enrolled at HCUC.
- The bursary holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

 - ii. Applicant's Identity Card (MyKad) front & back on one A4 size page.
- Submit the online application before the closing date.

Specific Terms & Conditions

- Only applicable for students who have graduated with a Bachelor's Degree within twelve (12) months from the application date of the Master's Degree.
- Only applicable for Master's Degree by Research (Full Time) students.
- Strictly limited to two (2) years during the Master's Degree.
- The bursary holder is required to maintain satisfactory progress in every progress monitoring cycle throughout their duration of study to enjoy the bursary, failing to do so, the bursary will be withdrawn. No appeal is allowed.
- The bursary holder is required to contribute hours every semester as stated below:

1. The application is open to Malaysian citizens only.
2. Applicants are allowed to apply for one Scholarship/Bursary only.
3. Scholarship and Bursary Awards are applicable for tuition fee payments only.
4. Applicants must fulfil the minimum entry requirements of the programme they are applying for. Fulfilling the minimum criteria does not automatically guarantee the applicant a Scholarship or Bursary. It is subject to a quota determined by HCUC.
5. Forecast/trial examination results or actual SPM results are accepted for the Scholarship/Bursary application. However, the forecast/trial examination results are only applicable for those who submit their enrollment application before the official SPM results are released, and the Scholarship/Bursary Awards quantum is only based on one of the better performing results.
6. All Scholarship and Bursary Awards offered are at the absolute discretion of HCUC and it is based on a first-come, first-served basis. All documents must be received by the stipulated deadlines. Late applications will not be considered.
7. All decisions made by HCUC for the Scholarship and Bursary Awards outcome are final and no further appeal shall be entertained.
8. HCUC reserves the right to revoke the Scholarship and Bursary Awards offered if the documents submitted contain false information. This includes incomplete applications without required attachments as stated in the Specific Terms and Conditions.
9. Scholarship and Bursary Awards are not applicable for payment of resitting or repeating of subjects.
10. Scholarship/Bursary Award offered will be automatically withdrawn and voided if the holder does not accept the award by the given deadline in the letter of offer.
11. Scholarship and Bursary holders need to ensure they uphold the reputation of HCUC at all times whether in verbal or written form through printed or social media.
12. Scholarship and Bursary holders need to provide testimonials, attend interviews and any other publicity-related activities which include Scholarship and Bursary Awards Presentation Ceremony when requested to.
13. For Scholarship/Bursary Awards that require for Contribution Hour, holder is required to assist the HCUC as and when required. Contribution Hour need to be fulfilled every semester as stated in the agreement. Failure to fulfil the Contribution Hour will result in the following actions to be taken:
 - a. Suspension and/or termination of the award of the Scholarship/Bursary, and
 - b. Repayment of the disbursed award of the Scholarship/Bursary for the affected semester if the holder fails to clear the remaining and/or outstanding Contribution Hour upon completion of the programme.
14. All Scholarship and Bursary Awards are fee waivers. They are not exchangeable for cash, non-refundable and non-transferable. No backdated Scholarship/Bursary will also be given out.
15. HCUC reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship/Bursary Award at any time, with immediate notice to the Scholarship/Bursary holder in writing, in the event of:
 - a. Failure to maintain the required CGPA every semester;
 - b. In cases of deferment/leave of absence/change of programme after commencement of semester;
 - c. Withdrawal from the programme of study;
 - d. Scholarship/Bursary holder is found to have committed misconduct either in study or otherwise;
 - e. Expulsion from the University College due to disciplinary offence, violation of HCUC rules and regulations including the terms and conditions mentioned herein;
 - f. All documents required for submission are not received by the stipulated deadlines.
16. Failure to complete one's study due to any of the above reasons would result in repayment of the Scholarship/Bursary awarded by the Han Chiang Education Fund.
17. Scholarship and Bursary Awards are only applicable for the programme applied. In case of programme transfer, the Scholarship/Bursary awarded will be withdrawn and the student needs to reapply before the stipulated deadline.
18. Scholarship and Bursary Awards are only applicable based on the required period of study for the programme. Scholarship and Bursary Awards will not be extended to additional study periods due to resits, repeats and/or study abroad programmes.
19. Scholarship and Bursary Awards will be applicable for the subsequent semesters on the condition that the Scholarship/Bursary holder fulfils the Specific and General Terms and Conditions specified here. Additionally, the Terms and Conditions stipulated in the Scholarship/Bursary Agreement must be strictly adhered to.
20. Scholarship and Bursary Awards are not applicable for any of the Dual Award Programmes.

Malaysian Social Entrepreneurs Foundation (MSEF)

- Scholarship approval is at the discretion of MSEF.
- The application is open to Malaysian citizens only.

I-BITA

Applicable to HCUC Diploma / HCUC Bachelor's Degree

- I-Bita is a one-off payment of RM1000 to students of HCUC by the Penang State Government.
