International students (who are not US Citizens or Permanent Residents) are eligible to apply for multiple scholarships, grants and bursaries, depending on their circumstances.

Our Admissions Scholarship Committee reviews each applicant individually for all scholarship and grant eligibility. We take an array of factors into consideration when making award determinations, such as personal, financial, academic, extracurricular, and other circumstances. We look at each student on a case by case basis, as we strive to award all deserving applicants. Students are only eligible to be evaluated or reviewed for bursaries and grants prior to registration, and must submit applications prior to the deadlines, when applicable, to be considered for scholarships and grants. All eligible students will be evaluated for awards at the time of admissions. In exceptional cases where a student is accepted after the application deadline, their case can be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Please note that all awards are for incoming first time students.

Health Profession Grant	Awarded to students who are currently or have been employed in the healthcare field in the past year.	MD4	Up to \$10,000	Students must be in their position for a least one year.
Legacy Grant	Scholarship awarded to all legacies of SGU School of Medicine.	MD4, MD5, MD6, MD7	Up to 10,000	A legacy is determined to be a child or grandchild of an SGU SOM Alumni.
Sibling Grant	Awarded to siblings attending St. George's University School of Medicine.	MD4, MD5, MD6, MD7	Up to 10,000	Only new incoming students will earn the award. The award is reviewed for at the time of admission.
Summer Academy Scholarship	Awarded to students who have participated in our Summer Academy Programs.	MD4, MD5, MD6, MD7	Cost of the tuition at the time of Summer Academy attendance	This grant is awarded at the time of admission to the University within our School of Medicine. The award is granted upon admission.

Charter Foundation Program Grant	Award offered to all students who successfully complete the Charter Foundation Program.	Charter Foundation Program students who matriculate to MD4	Cost of tuition of the Charter Foundation Program.	All students are granted the cost of tuition of the Charter Foundation Program term they attended upon matriculation to MD4.
Global Scholars Bursary	Exclusive for students accepted to SGU-NU MD4 year program.	SGU-NU MD4	Partial tuition.	This award is based on individual financial need. Students wishing to be reviewed for the Global Scholars Bursary must submit the Confidential Financial Statement (CFS).
International Peace and Country Bursary	Award for demonstrated financial need.	MD4, MD5, MD6, MD7, SGU-NU MD5	Partial tuition. Please note that the SGU-NU MD5 program has a Preclinical Year I award cap of £6,307 GBP overall/£3,153 per term.	The International Peace and Country Bursary is based on individual financial need. Students wishing to be reviewed for the International Peace Bursary must submit the Confidential Financial Statement (CFS). The award is not intended to cover the full cost of tuition and students must fund their education beyond this award.
Humanitarian Scholarship	Awarded for demonstrated compassion and commitment to humanitarian causes.	MD4	Partial tuition.	There is no scholarship application for this award, and students seeking evaluation for this award should submit an overview of dates and hours of community service they delivered to their Admission Officer.
Chancellor's Circle Legacy of Excellence	Awarded for academic excellence in Undergraduate Studies.	MD4	\$94,500 USD	This award is automatically granted to accepted students meeting the below outlined academic criteria; no separate application is required. Minimum academic requirements: * 3.7 Overall UG GPA * 3.5 Science UG GPA * 506 MCAT points
Legacy of Excellence Scholarship	Awarded for academic excellence in Undergraduate Studies.	MD4	Partial tuition.	This award is automatically reviewed for eligibility upon admission and is awarded to students who exceed our academic criteria. The grades should be above our minimum requirements: * 3.3 Overall GPA * 3.2 Science GPA * MCAT score is not a requirement for international student eligibility. If the student does take the MCAT, with an average score of 498 or above, that will be taken into consideration.

Maintaining your award is not contingent upon achieving an academic threshold. All awards granted are sustained throughout the applicant's attendance unless otherwise noted in the terms & conditions of the award.
