The Griffith Global Excellence Scholarship (GGES Malaysia)

Available for learners applying from Malaysia for full-time masters programmes at Griffith College (Dublin, Cork and Limerick).

This scholarship programme is in addition to the Griffith College standard scholarships offering. Details of which can be found at <https://www.griffith.ie/admissions/fees/non-eu-tuition-fees>

In this annual competition, a limited number of students applying from Malaysia will be awarded a **50% tuition fee scholarship**.

GGES applicants must also have the means to fund their remaining tuition fees and their cost of living while studying in Ireland.

The GGES selection committee will evaluate the 50% scholarship application based on:

- 1 CGPA
- 2 English language proficiency
- 3 All other programme entry requirements

Applicants who wish to apply for this programme must apply through an approved Griffith College representative. The percentage (%) Student Advisory Service Fee (SASF) for advising GGES applicants will be 10%. Applications made by Griffith College representatives will be on that basis only.
