Pro Vice-Chancellor International Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

- Non-Malaysian citizen
- Full-time enrolled student in ANY degree program at Curtin Malaysia
- Curtin Malaysia foundation moving to degree with minimum CWA 80%
- Curtin Malaysia diploma moving to degree with minimum CWA 80%
- Current Curtin Malaysia degree students (second year onwards) with the latest CWA 80%
- Not presently holding other scholarships.

Amount of award & duration

The scholarship covers 50% of the tuition fee for the entire duration of the programme (3 – 4 years depending on the programme of study).

**All other fees and expenses are to be borne by the recipients.*

Note:

- The CWA of 80% must be achieved at the time of application.
- Please also note that students meeting the criteria are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The scholarship is not guaranteed as all applications go through a selection process. Only selected students will receive the scholarship.

Application process:

- The application must be submitted with all the required documents as below:
- Complete the online application form. Please login using your Curtin Malaysia student webmail or gmail
- Copy of your passport or IC No
- Copy of academic e-record.
