Undergraduate

Most of our Undergraduate Bachelor degree courses will consider:

- A-Levels: BBC - BBB
- IB: 29 – 32 points
- STPM: BBB
- UEC: a pass in all subjects in the UEC Senior Middle Level examinations with a minimum of five subjects at B4 or above.
- ATAR 80.00 or above

English language requirement for UG:

- C6/C in SPM English syllabus 1119
- IELTS: 6.0
- TOEFL IBT:76

Postgraduate (taught)

Minimum requirement

Bachelor's degree: 2.2 OR GPA 2.70

English language requirement for PG:

- IELTS 6.0-7.5
- TOEFL IBT 76-100

FUNDING AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Essex Global Partner Scholarship

Undergraduate scholarships are available for students from our partner institutions and pathways. Students are entitled to up to a 20% tuition fee discount, depending on which partner institution and channel you're transferred from.

IB scholarship

£2,000 award if you've obtained 34 points or more in the International Baccalaureate.

South East Asia undergraduate scholarships

£3,000 awards are available through this scheme.

Essex Global Talent Scholarship

International undergraduate or master's students may be eligible for a competitive scholarship covering 50% of first-year tuition, based on academic and extracurricular achievements.

Academic Excellence International Masters' Scholarships

Awards of £4,000 are available for Masters students through this scheme.
