Financial Assistance for Sarawakian - Yayasan Sarawak Loan

First of all, we would like to extend our sincere appreciation for your continued efforts in promoting Curtin University Malaysia to prospective students. Your commitment is instrumental to our collective goal of broadening access to quality education.

As we work collectively towards the July and October 2025 intakes, we kindly remind you to promote *Yayasan Sarawak Loan* – *Biasiswa Pinjaman Pelajaran Dalam Negara* to eligible Sarawakian. This financial support can significantly ease their path toward higher education, and your guidance in highlighting this opportunity is greatly appreciated.

Below is a summary of the financial support requirements and application procedure for your reference;

Yayasan Sarawak Loan "Biasiswa Pinjaman Pelajaran Dalam Negara"

Requirements:

- 1. Sarawakian (at least one of the parents is Sarawakian)
- 2. Malaysian citizen
- 3. Age not exceeding:
 - 45 years for Bachelor's Degree studies
 - 50 years for Master's and PhD studies
- 4. Pursuing full-time studies and NOT through Distance Learning (DL) mode
- 5. Has no other sponsorship
- 6. It is mandatory to obtain a credit in the Bahasa Melayu subject in the SPM examination or an equivalent examination as follows:
 - Obtained at least a Grade C for the Malaysian Certificate of Education (SPM)
 - Obtained at least a Grade C for the General Certificate of Ordinary Level (GCE O-Level)
 - Obtained at least a Grade B6 for the Unified Examination Certificate (UEC)
- 7. Two (2) guarantors who have a permanent job and are not exceeding 60 years old
- 8. Loan repayment starts 12 months after graduation.

Required Documents:

- 1. Curtin University's Letter of Offer (Foundation/ Diploma/ Degree)
- 2. A copy of the student's IC
- 3. A copy of the Parents' IC
- 4. Results/Transcript of Previous Exams, e.g., SPM, Foundation, Diploma, or Degree
- 5. Pay Slips of Parents / Guarantors
- 6. Unemployed Parent Provide a Certification Letter from Pegawai Kelas A/Penghulu/Kapitan/Ketua Kampung (if applicable)
- 7. Pensioner Card & Pensioner Statement (if applicable)
