**Citizenship/Residency Requirements:** Must be a full-fee paying international student. May **not** be a citizen of New Zealand or Australia, hold a New Zealand residence class visa, or be a Permanent Resident of Australia

Selection will be based on:

- quality of academic achievement in a programme of study as defined in clause 2.3 (and note 2) of the regulations;
- character, and evidence of leadership potential, and of involvement in cultural, sport, and/or community activities;
- financial circumstances; and
- strategic objectives of the University.

#### Additional Information:

If, during the tenure of a scholarship, a recipient's immigration status changes so that they are no longer a full-fee-paying international student and thereby obtain a partial refund of academic fees from the University, the scholarship is withdrawn, and any scholarship money paid since the status change was recorded at the University is refunded to the University.
