

Faculty of Science Undergraduate Scholarships for International Students

Scholarships of between £6,000 - £7,000 per year of study are available to new international students joining an eligible undergraduate degree in the Faculty of Science in the 2026/27 academic year. Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis to candidates who hold an offer of admission and demonstrate excellent academic performance (current and/or previously gained) and any relevant extracurricular or professional experience.

Scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis. Awards may be allocated early in the application cycle and so making an early application for admission is advised.

Duration: Annually for the duration of UG studies, subject to academic progression

Eligibility

In order to be considered for a Faculty of Science Undergraduate Scholarship for International Students, candidates must:

- Be a new, international fee-paying student holding an offer of admission for either year one, or year two entry, to a full-time, Glasgow campus based, undergraduate degree in the Faculty of Science for the 2026/27 academic year.
- Have achieved excellent grades to date in their academic studies.
- Be self-funded. Students who receive full scholarships, for example from a government office or embassy, will not be eligible.

Subject eligibility

Biochemistry, Biology & biological sciences, Biomedical science, Chemistry, Computer science, Forensic science, Immunology, Mathematics & statistics, Microbiology, Pharmacology, Pharmacy & biomedical sciences

Terms and conditions

- Applicants must meet all of the above eligibility criteria to be considered for a Faculty of Science Undergraduate Scholarship for International Students.
- Applicants who have been awarded a scholarship will be notified within four weeks of submitting their scholarship application form.
- To receive their scholarship, awardees must enrol in the 2026/27 academic year and continue to meet all of the above eligibility criteria throughout their studies.
- The value of each scholarship will be between £6,000 and £7,000 per year of study. The scholarship will be awarded towards the payment of a student's tuition fee annually, subject to academic progression.

- Successful candidates will be selected on their academic performance (current and/or previously gained) and any relevant extra-curricular or professional experience. The allocation and value of awards will be based on the Faculty of Science's strategic priorities.
- Students who defer their offer of admission will not be eligible.
- Students who transfer to a degree out with the Faculty of Science will no longer be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis. Awards may be allocated early in the application cycle.
- The deadline for consideration is 31 July 2026.
- Students are only eligible to hold one scholarship per academic year from the University of Strathclyde.
- The Faculty of Science's decision on the awarding of scholarships is final. Appeals will not be considered.

Eligibility

In order to receive an Undergraduate Scholarship for Physics International Students, candidates must:

- Be a new, international fee-paying student who registers for either year one, or year two, of a fulltime undergraduate degree in the Department of Physics, starting in September 2026.
- Be self-funded. Students who receive full scholarships, for example from a government office or embassy, will not be eligible.

Terms and condition

- Students must meet all of the above eligibility criteria to receive an Undergraduate Scholarship for Physics International Students. The scholarship will be awarded automatically, no separate scholarship application is necessary.
- To receive their scholarship, awardees must enrol in the 2026/27 academic year and continue to meet all of the above eligibility criteria throughout their studies.
- The value of the Undergraduate Scholarships for Physics International Students is £7,000. The scholarship will be awarded towards the payment of a student's tuition fee annually, subject to academic progression.
- The scholarship are for new international fee-paying students only and cannot be deferred or transferred to any other entry points.
- Students who transfer to a degree out with the Department of Physics will no longer be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- Students are only eligible for one scholarship per academic year from the University of Strathclyde.
- The Faculty of Science's decision on the awarding of scholarships is final. Appeals will not be considered.
