



## **Murdoch University Programme Rebate**

The rebate is offered to applicants who have enrolled to a Murdoch University programme with the aim of supporting their undergraduate and postgraduate studies with Kaplan Higher Education Academy (KHEA) in Singapore.

### **Eligibility Requirements for S\$3,000 rebate for Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree and Postgraduate Degree programme**

- Applicants must be new students enrolling directly into a Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree or Postgraduate Degree programme offered by Kaplan. Applicants who have previously been enrolled in a Kaplan Diploma programme or a Degree programme through Kaplan are not eligible.
- Meeting the entry requirements for Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree programme or Postgraduate Degree programme offered by Kaplan.

### **Eligibility Requirements for S\$1,000 rebate for Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree and Postgraduate Degree programme**

- Applicants must be existing Kaplan students, progressing to their next level of studies.
- Meeting the entry requirements for Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree or Postgraduate Degree programme offered by Kaplan.
- The rebate does not apply to Graduate Certificate in Business Administration and Graduate Certificate in Information Technology.

#### **Value**

- S\$3,000 rebate for new students enrolling in Murdoch University's Bachelor's or Postgraduate Degree programme.
- S\$1,000 rebate for applicants progressing from Kaplan Diploma to a Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree programme.
- S\$1,000 rebate for applicants progressing from a Murdoch University's Bachelor's Degree programme to a Murdoch University's Postgraduate Degree programme.
- All rebates are exclusive of GST.

#### **Schedule of Payment, Duration and Other Conditions**

- The rebate is only applicable to international applicants.
- The rebate is valid for intakes happening in 2026 for Full-Time students.
- The rebate will be offset against the final instalment payment for the applicable programme fee.
- The rebate will be forfeited if the applicant withdraws from, defers or fails to complete the programme.
- The rebate is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. For the avoidance of doubt, if the student defers to a later intake of the programme, the rebate cannot be transferred to that other intake.
- The rebate may be withdrawn at any time if the student's progress or behaviour is deemed unsatisfactory, as determined at the reasonable discretion of Kaplan, including if the student breaches or is subsequently found to have breached any applicable law, does not exemplify conduct or performance (whether academic or others) of a deserving student and/or any disciplinary action is taken against the awardee.
- If the rebate is forfeited or withdrawn for any reason, the student will not be eligible for any further subsequent award of the rebate.
- A student who receives the rebate will not be entitled to any other rebates, promotions and offers (except for the application fee waiver, if applicable).
- All international students must adhere to the standard application procedures for enrolment with KHEA. This process includes awaiting the letter of offer issued by KHEA as well as the Student's Pass issued by the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) of Singapore. Awardees must meet the requirements set by both KHEA and ICA.
- Kaplan reserves the rights to amend, suspend or discontinue this rebate at any time without notice. In the event of any dispute, the decision of Kaplan will be final and binding.
