## Merit-Based Scholarships and Early Action Opportunities

Studying at a top US university is more accessible than ever – but scholarship opportunities are limited and competitive.

This guide highlights potential scholarship opportunities at select US universities. Award amounts shown represent maximum possible values; individual offers will vary based on eligibility, academic merit, and availability throughout the cycle, with the **strongest scholarship opportunities available earlier in the cycle.**

In Fall 2025, Shorelight's signature partner institutions awarded more than **\$9 million** in scholarships to international students.

**Act early to maximize your students' scholarship potential.**

### Why **Applying Early** Matters

Students who apply earlier are typically considered for a broader range of scholarship opportunities, while later applicants may have fewer awards available. For Fall 2025, approximately 70% of available Shorelight scholarships were awarded to qualified students who applied by March 31.

#### Partner Tip for Fall 2026

Students who deposit by **March 31** have access to the **highest-value scholarships.** After this date, maximum scholarship amounts decrease and incentive availability becomes more limited.

#### Additional Awards & Limited-Time Incentives

Students may also be eligible for additional incentives, such as:



##### **Early Pay Tuition Lock**

By submitting tuition and other payments by May 31, students can secure their current rate and bypass future increases, typically resulting in a 3–5% reduction in total costs.



##### **Short Term Summer Program Discount**

Receive a 20% discount on select two-week short-term summer programs. Students may participate in a summer session this year or apply the discount toward a future summer term. Program options and eligibility may vary based on timing, destination, and individual student qualifications.



##### **Free Virtual Internship**

Gain professional experience with a complimentary virtual internship, valued at \$950.

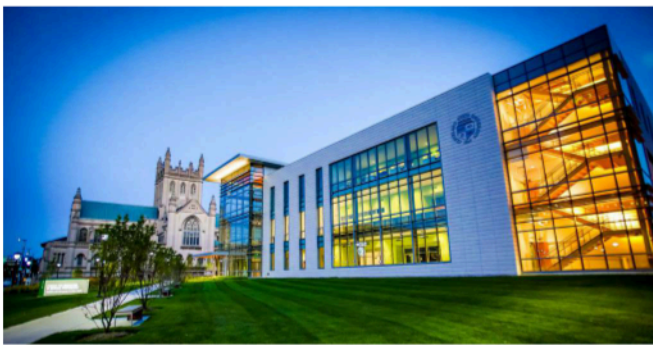

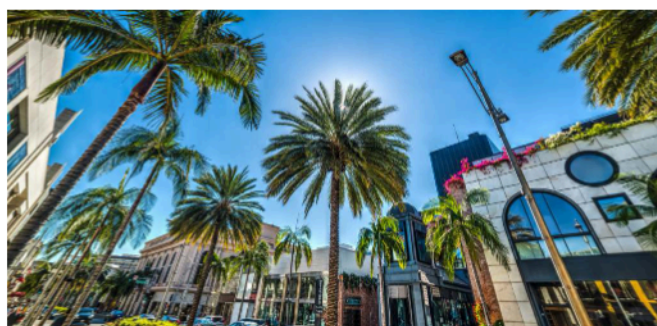

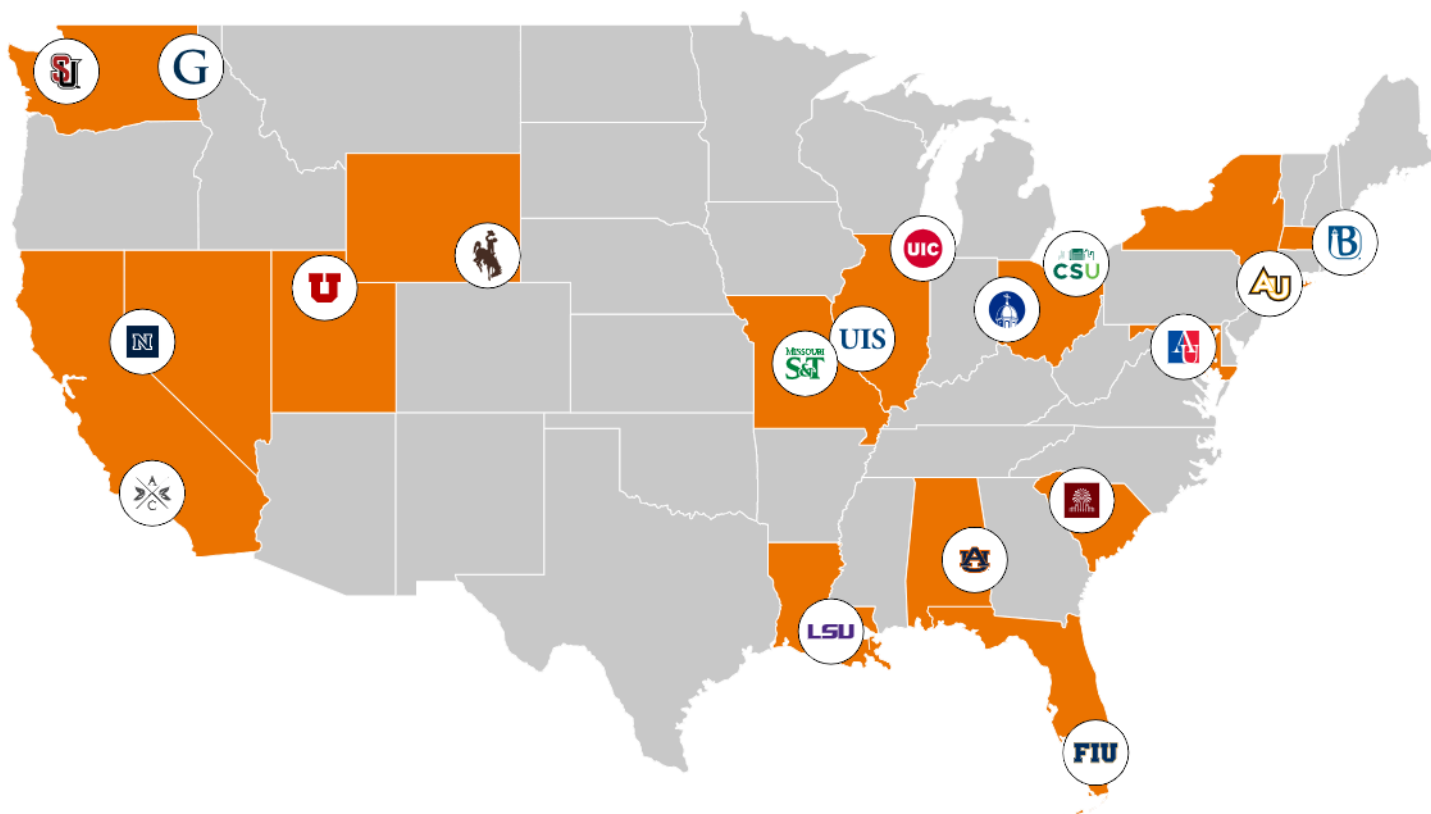

- Students enrolling at Florida International University (FIU) will receive Career Credential and Certification Preparation in place of the virtual internship.
- The free virtual internship and the short-term summer program discount may not be combined.
- Tuition and fees are subject to change at any time. Tuition may vary by program, academic term, enrollment status, or other factors as determined by the institution.
- Dining costs are not guaranteed and may change at any time. Final charges will be based on actual rates at the time of billing.
- Housing costs depend on availability, especially in certain schools where housing availability is limited.
- Scholarships are limited and not guaranteed. Availability may change and awards may be modified at any time.
- To qualify for early payment, students must meet the payment terms for each month during the offer period.
