| ASEAN International Student Bursary | A scholarship offered to applicants from ASEAN countries (excluding Malaysia) who are enrolling to selected undergraduate courses at UNM | Open to students from ASEAN countries (excluding Malaysia) pursuing listed undergraduate courses* at UNM | 15% reduction in annual tuition fees. Students may combine this scholarship with HAS or DES, subject to meeting the respective scholarship eligibility criteria | Students must successfully progress to the next academic year | The Admissions Office will assess eligibility during the standard application review, based on the passport submitted during application. | |
| Study Abroad Programme Scholarship | This scholarship is offered to recognize and strengthen academic collaborations between UNM and its approved partner universities. It supports eligible incoming students from partner institutions who wish to undertake a study period at UNM | Offered exclusively to students from partner universities approved by UNM. | Recipients will receive a 20% reduction for one or two semesters. | It is only extended during the study period at UNM, either one semester or two semesters. | The scholarship is automatically granted, based on the applicant's home institution being listed among UNM's approved partner universities. | |

| Postgraduate Taught Excellence Scholarship | UNM celebrates academic achievement through its PGT Excellence Scholarship for students undertaking PGT courses, including Postgraduate Certificate and Postgraduate Diploma, whether full-time or part-time. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants must meet all entry requirements for the programme A strong upper second-class honours degree (minimum 65% average under the British system) or a CGPA of 3.4 out of 4 (for Malaysian or USA qualification) is required. International qualifications will be considered on an equivalent basis.
