2026 International Students

Our largest award is the Brock Scholars awards. These awards are automatic and open to every incoming student from anywhere in the world. To qualify, you must be entering your first undergraduate program (no previous post-secondary experience).

Your admission average is calculated using the prerequisites for your offered program of study. A Brock Scholars Award is offered at the time of admission and may increase or decrease if your final average changes. **Students entering from the U.S.A are eligible for the Domestic Brock Scholars Entrance Award. International students who become domestic students or have status to pay the equivalent to domestic tuitions will have their International Brock Scholars award converted to the Domestic Brock Scholars to align with the change to domestic fees.**

Brock Future Leaders Scholarship	\$10,000.00	10 awards available. Must meet requirements and may only be combined with the Brock Scholars Award.. Selection by committee. Apply below.
International Curriculum awards	\$3,000	Awarded to the first 20 accepted students who are admitted as international fee-paying students, have graduated from a high school outside of Canada, paid their deposit, and hold an international curriculum.
International Ambassador Award	Variable- Equal to domestic tuition (only) rates	Must meet requirements. Selection by committee. Apply below.
The Caribbean International Scholarship	\$4,000	Awarded to two (2) 1st year undergraduate students, admitted as international fee-paying students who show academic promise and financial need. Applicable countries: Cuba; Haiti; Dominican Republic; Jamaica; Trinidad & Tobago; Guadeloupe; Martinique; Bahamas; Barbados; Saint Lucia; Curacao; Aruba; Saint Vincent and the Grenadines; Grenada; Antigua and Barbuda; Dominica; Cayman Islands; Saint Kitts & Nevis; Saint Maarten; Turks & Caicos Islands; Saint Martin; British Virgin Islands; Caribbean Netherlands; Anguilla; Saint Barthelemy and Montserrat
Brock Canadian High School Excellence Award	\$2,000	Awarded to the first 30 accepted students who are admitted as international fee-paying students, have paid their deposit and graduate from high school in Canada.
International Transfer Award	\$3,000	Awarded to the first 10 accepted students who are admitted as international fee-paying students, have paid their deposit and transferred at least 0.5 credits.
